First: Say Something to God Every Day (Prayer)

- Romans 12:12

with all prayer and supplication praying at all seasons in the Spirit, and watching thereunto in all perseverance and supplication for all the saints
- Ephesians 6:18

In nothing be anxious; but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God - Philippians 4:6

Continue steadfastly in prayer, watching therein with thanksgiving
- Colossians 4:2

Second: Let God Say Something to You

Every Day (Bible Reading)

This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth, but thou shalt meditate thereon day and night, that thou may observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success
- Joshua 1:8

But his delight is in the law of Jehovah; And on his law doth he meditate day and night - Psalm 1:2

Now these were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, examining the scriptures daily, whether these things were so - Acts 17:11

Third: Say Something for God Every Day (Teaching)

Every day will I bless thee; And I will praise thy name for ever and ever - Psalm 145:2

And every day, in the temple and at home, they ceased not to teach and to preach Jesus as the Christ - Acts 5:42

But when some were hardened and disobedient, speaking evil of the Way before the multitude, he departed from them, and separated the disciples, reasoning daily in the school of Tyrannus

but sanctify in your hearts Christ as Lord: being ready always to give answer to every man that asks you a reason concerning the hope that is in you, yet with meekness and fear
- 1 Peter 3:15

Fourth: Do Something for God Every Day (Good Works)

And he said unto all, If any man would come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me Luke 9:23

Now there was at Joppa a certain disciple named Tabitha, which by interpretation is called Dorcas: this woman was full of good works and alms deeds which she did - Acts 9:36

For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God afore prepared that we should walk in them - Ephesians 2:10
