

Who Are We? - cont.

We speak only where the Bible speaks (1 Peter 4:11; Isaiah 8:20).

No Life But Christ. We do not live in a way that follows the pattern of the world: vulgar language, immodesty, drinking, gambling, homosexuality, abortion, etc. We live only as Christ would have us to live and pattern our life after his example (Romans 8:29; 1 Corinthians 11:1; Galatians 2:20; 4:19; 1 Peter 2:21).

No Hope But Heaven. We do not preach a future hope that is based upon the wishes of men: rapture, earthly paradise, reincarnation, nirvana, 70 virgins, rule your own planet, etc. We preach only the one hope of the gospel: heaven (Ephesians 4:4; Colossians 1:5; Titus 1:2; 3:7).

So, who are we? We are New Testament "Christians" only (Acts 11:26; 26:28; 1 Peter 4:16). We are one of many local "churches of Christ" around the world seeking to serve Jesus (Romans 16:16). Let us all examine ourselves to see who we really are and make the change if necessary (2 Corinthians 13:5). Will you come join us and be a simple, New Testament Christian?

Who are the Christians of the Warfield Blvd. church of Christ? We have...

No Creed But Christ. We do not follow any man-made creeds (“I believe”). We follow only the doctrine of Christ (John 16:13-15; 1 Corinthians 2:16; 4:17; 9:21; 14:37; Galatians 6:2).

No Book But the Bible. We do not follow any man-made books, catechisms, manuals, confessions, decrees, etc. We follow only the New Testament (Acts 2:42; Galatians 1:6-9; Ephesians 2:20; James 1:25; 2:12; 2 Timothy 3:16-17).

No Church But Christ’s Church. We are not a part of any man-made church: Catholic, Protestant, Jewish, Muslim, Buddhist, etc. We are part of the Lord’s church only (Matthew 16:18; Acts 2:47; 20:28; 1 Corinthians 3:11; Eph. 1:22-23; 4:4-6; 5:23).

No Worship But True Worship. We do not engage in any man-made worship that is vain (Matthew 15:9), ignorant (Acts 17:23), or self-willed (Colossians 2:23). We engage only in worship that is authorized by God’s word (John 4:24; Colossians

3:17). We sing (Ephesians 5:19), pray (Acts 2:42), study the Bible (Acts 2:42), take the Lord’s supper (Acts 20:7; 1 Corinthians 11:23-33), and give our contribution (1 Corinthians 16:1-2; 2 Corinthians 9:7).

No Organization But Local. We do not have any ties to any man-made, earthly organization: conventions, confer-



ences, synods, councils, dioceses, etc. We are part of a local church only (Acts 20:28; Philippians 1:1-2; 1 Peter 5:1-2) with Jesus as our head (Ephesians 1:21-23).

No Mission But Soul-Winning. We do not engage in any kind of work related to politics, recreation, entertainment, so-

cial work, secular education, etc. We focus only on the work Christ: edifying the saved (Acts 11:22-26); helping the needy saints (Acts 11:27-30); and, evangelizing the lost (Acts 13:1-3).

No Plan But the Gospel. We do not preach a man-made plan of salvation: faith only, voting, etc. We preach only the gospel plan of salvation (Romans 1:16). This plan includes hearing (Acts 15:7; Ephesians 1:13), believing (John 8:24; 20:30-31), repenting (Acts 17:30-31), confessing (Romans 10:9-10), being baptized (Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38; 22:16), and living faithfully (Romans 6:4).

No Unity But the Bible. We do not promote a man-made unity that says, “Let’s all agree to disagree” ... “Let’s agree on Christ, but not the Church” ... etc. We promote only the unity that Jesus prayed for – unity through his word (John 17:20-21; 1 Corinthians 1:10; Ephesians 4:4-6).

No Speech But Bible Speech. We avoid man-made religious language that is not found in the Bible like “Reverend,” “Pastor” (for the preacher), “Father,” “join the church of your choice,” “pray through and get religion,” “a second work of grace,” etc.
