### **Look Down That Lonesome Road** by Bill Reeves

“Look down, look down that lonesome road, before you travel on. Look up, look up and seek your maker 'fore Gabriel blows his horn.”

It came out, I believe, in 1927 and I have sung it many times—such a good message, especially for young people leaving home for the first time to go to college or to a distant job. They are going to be on their own as they travel a lonesome road without parental guidance and provisions, but alone, compared to the home-life that from birth they had earlier known. They need to look down that road ahead of them and know that it is beset with sin, temptation and worldliness. "The whole world lieth in the evil one (1 Jn. 5:19), led by the evil one (Jn. 17:15), and is the present evil world (Gal. 1:4)." They need to consider that road ahead before traveling on, and like the wise son of Ezek. 18:14,28, consider the sins of others (of even parents!), and fear, turning away from transgressions! He needs to always imitate that which is good

(3 Jn. 11).

I. He needs to look down that road ahead of him. He needs to look:

a. at the rainbow along with God and remember that God has made a covenant with man (Gen. 9:16), along with other covenants (Heb. 8:8-13).

b. not on the outward appearance, but like Jehovah, look on the heart, 1 Sam. 16:7.

c. not upon a virgin to covet her, per his covenant with God, Job 31:1, Matt. 5:28.

d. not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal, 2 Cor. 4:18. (He needs to seek the things that are above where Christ is, Col. 3:1).

e. therefore carefully how he walks, not as unwise, but as wise, Eph. 5:15.

f. for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness, 2 Pet. 3:13.

g. to himself, that he lose not the

things which the apostles have wrought, but that he receive a full reward, 2 Jn. 1:8.

h. unto Jesus the author and perfecter of his faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising shame, and hath sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

He must keep looking down that road as he travels on, on his own. (Of course if he is a Christian he is not absolutely alone; God is with him (Phil. 4:9). The things which ye both learned and received and heard and saw in me, these things do: and the God of peace shall be with you.

II. He needs to look up and seek his Maker! This is a must as he walks down that lonely road of life, hazardous, arduous and excessive. Atheists with their theory of organic evolution to the contrary, Intelligent Design (Rom. 1 20-23) is clearly seen in the universe that surrounds us and God's Power and Divinity are clearly manifested. Like every house is built by someone (Heb. 3:4); the universe didn't simply come from nothing! The presence of a house is proof that a builder was or is near. Nothing creates nothing. Matter cannot create mind! It
