The Sin of Jealousy



- Characteristics of Jealousy
 - Jealously cannot stand it when others are doing better. – Gen. 26:12–14
 - Jealously is sad at the happiness of others. – Lk. 15
 - Makes us hostile towards those that never harmed us. – Gen. 37
 - It fails to recognize that God knows what He is doing in apportioning gifts. – Ps. 139

The Sin of Jealousy



- Consequences of Jealousy
 - It rots your bones – Prov. 14:30
 - Gives birth to unwarranted anger and suspicion. – 1 Sam. 18:6–9
 - Breeds a destructive spirit – Dan. 6:3–5
 - It will ruin your spiritual appetite – 1 Pet. 2:1–3
 - It brings chaos – Jas. 3:13–16

The Sin of Jealousy



- The Cure for Jealousy
 - Recognize it is sin – 1 Cor. 3:2–3
 - Confess it Repent – 1 Jn. 1:8–9
 - Train yourself out of it – 1 Tim. 4:7–8
