Applications for Today

- 1. Paul went from being zealous for God in the wrong way to being zealous for God in the right way (22:3; Gal. 2:10).

- 3. How you treat Christians is how you treat Christ himself (22:7-8; Mt. 25:34-45).
- 4. Contrary to erroneous religious teaching today, one must "do" something to be saved (22:10; Acts 2:37; 16:30; Mt. 19:16).
- 5. God's will can be known (22:14; Eph. 5:17).
- 6. Jesus is the Righteous One (22:14; Acts 3:14; 7:52).
