Or what king, as he goes to encounter another king in war, will not sit down first and take counsel whether he is able with ten thousand to meet him that cometh against him with twenty thousand? Or else, while the other is yet a great way off, he sends an ambassador, and asks conditions of peace. So therefore whosoever he be of you that renounces not all that he hath, he cannot be my disciple.
