

God Speaks - cont.

God has always spoken through his creation (Psalm 19:1ff; Rom. 1:19-20). And in times past, God has spoken directly to mankind through his words (Hebrews 1:1-2). But, the question now is: How does God speak to mankind today?

Sincere, religious individuals today claim “special” revelations from God. They say “God speaks to me.” Religious groups have also claimed that God has spoken to them through prophets (Mormons, Seventh-day Adventists, J.W.s, UPC, cults, etc.). Sincere preachers (including some among “Churches of Christ”) tell about what “the Lord has laid on my heart...”

Again, the question is: How does God speak to mankind today? The answer: God speaks today through the New Testament only. With the New Testament we have...

... “all things” and “all truth” (John 14:26; 16:13)
... the “perfect is come” (1 Corinthians 13:10; see also James 1:25)
... the “one faith” (Ephesians 4:5)
... “all wisdom” (Colossians 1:28)
... the “complete” (2 Timothy 3:16-17)
... “all things” (2 Peter 1:3)
... the faith “once for all” delivered (Jude 3)

God Speaks - cont.

The New Testament is divine, not human in origin (Galatians 1:11-12); it is pure, not perverted in quality (2 Corinthians 11:3); it is complete, not partial in provision (2 Timothy 3:17); and, it is necessary, not optional in requirement (2 Thessalonians 1:8). Friend, will you listen to how God speaks to you today in the New Testament? - *Chris Reeves*
