- Word of the Week -

“Lord” (Gr. κύριος), meaning master or ruler, is applied both to God (Luke 1:32; Acts 3:22; etc.) and Jesus (Mark 16:19; Luke 24:3) in the New Testament. Because God the Father and God the Son are di-
vine, they have all power and all authority. We are not our own power and authority. We must submit, as hard as that is some-
times, and let God and Jesus be our Lord. Submitting to the “Lord God” will bring us
righteous judgment (Revelation 15:3) and submitted to the “Lord Jesus” will lead us
to eternal life (Jude 21).
