For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh, for the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh, but divinely powerful for the destruction of fortresses.
- 2 Corinthians 10:3-4 -

Considering that this is the last Sunday of 2025, it is very likely that many of you have already begun to plan for next year. Planning, of course, is a good thing. But, I would remind us all of two things. First, we must say “if the Lord wills” regarding our future plans (James 4:15). Second, we must not neglect what must be done “today” as we prepare for the future. Here are some things we must do “today” and not put off until next year.

1. Today is the day to hear the voice of the Lord. Will you read your Bible today?

Wherefore, even as the Holy Spirit saith, To-day if ye shall hear his voice, Harden not your hearts, as in the provocation, Like as in the day of the trial in the wilderness, Where your fathers tried me by proving me, And saw my works forty years. Wherefore I was displeased with this generation, And said, They do always err in their heart: But they did not know my ways; As I swore in my wrath, They shall not enter into my rest.
- Hebrews 3:7-11 -

2. Today is the day for exhortation. Will you be exhorted and exhort others with words of encouragement?

Take heed, brethren, lest haply there shall be in any one of you an evil heart of unbelief, in falling away from the living God: but exhort one another day by day, so long as it is called To-day; lest any one of you be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin: for we are become partakers of Christ, if we hold fast the beginning of our confidence firm unto the end: while it is said, To-day if ye shall hear his voice, Harden not your hearts, as in the provocation.
- Hebrews 3:12-15 -

3. Today is the day to prepare for your rest. Will you make ready for your rest in heaven?

Seeing therefore it remains that some should enter thereinto, and they to whom the good tidings were before preached failed to enter in because of disobedience, he again defines a certain day, To-day, saying in David so long a time afterward (even as hath been said before), To-day if ye shall hear his voice, Harden not your hearts. For if Joshua had given them rest, he would not have spoken afterward of another day. There remains therefore a sabbath rest for the people of God. For he that is entered into his rest hath himself also rested from his works, as God did from his. Let us therefore give diligence to enter into that rest, that no man fall after the same example of disobedience
- Hebrews 4:6-11 -

4. Today is the day of salvation. Will you obey the gospel as a lost sinner, or return to the Jesus as an erring saint?

And working together with him we entreat also that ye receive not the grace of God in vain (for he saith, At an acceptable time I hearkened unto thee, And in a day of salvation did I succor thee: behold, now is the acceptable time; behold, now is the day of salvation)

4. Today is the day of work. Will you be busy doing the Lord’s work of evangelism, edification, and benevolence?

But what think ye? A man had two sons; and he came to the first, and said, Son, go work to-day in the vineyard

5. Today is the day of decision. Will you choose to serve the Lord?
