**Questions**

1. What time did the word of the Lord come to Jeremiah and what was going on at this time (32:1-2)?
  
2. Where was Jeremiah at this time and what caused him to be there (32:2-5)?
  
3. What did the Lord tell Jeremiah and what did he buy (32:6-15)?
  
4. What did Jeremiah do after his purchase and what did he say about the Lord and about the current situation in Jerusalem (32:16-25)?
  
5. What did the Lord tell Jeremiah about Jerusalem and Nebuchadnezzar (32:26-29)?
  
6. Why did the Lord bring judgment upon Jerusalem by Nebuchadnezzar (32:30-35)?
  
7. What good things did the Lord promise would come after the captivity (32:36-44)?
  
8. Where was Jeremiah the second time that the Lord spoke to him and what did he tell Jeremiah to do (33:1-3)?
  
9. What did the Lord promise to do after the captivity of Israel and Judah (33:4-9)?
  
10. What would be heard in Jerusalem again after the captivity (33:10-11)?

11. What would be found in the lands and cities after the captivity (33:12-13)?
12. What would the Branch of righteousness do for Israel in the future (33:14-17)?
13. What covenant did the Lord make before the captivity that would not, and could not, be broken after the captivity (33:19-26)?

### **Digging Deeper**

1. When was the “tenth year of Zedekiah” and the “eighteenth year of Nebuchadnezzar” (32:1)? Where in 2 Kings and 2 Chronicles are we told about the same events?
2. Where is Anathoth located on a map (32:8-9)?
3. How did the promises of the Lord in 32:36-44 relate to Jeremiah buying a field in 32:6-15?
4. Who is the “Branch of righteousness” (33:15)?

### **Applications for Today**

1. Preaching the truth may bring persecution (32:2-5; 2 Tim. 3:11-12).
2. Believe in the promises of God and then act upon that belief (32:15; 2 Pet. 1:4).
3. Pray to the Lord when you don't understand everything (32:16-25; 2 Tim. 2:7).
4. Nothing is too hard for the Lord (32:17, 27; Gen. 18:14).
5. The Lord is both good and severe (32:18; Rom. 11:22).
6. The Lord is great in all things (32:18-19; Psa. 147:5).

7. God's people should be united in heart to fear the Lord (Jer. 32:39-40; Acts 4:32).
8. Call upon the Lord in prayer and he will answer you (33:3; Psa. 17:6).
9. The Lord can cleanse one of his sin (33:8; 1 Jn. 1:7-9).
10. Give thanks to the Lord for all his goodness (33:11; 1 Thess. 5:18).
11. Jesus is the "Branch of righteousness" (33:15-16; 1 Cor. 1:30).
12. Jesus sits presently on David's throne (33:19-26; Lk. 1:32-33).
