**Jeremiah 45-47**

**Questions**

1. What did Baruch say during his difficult times and what was the Lord's response to him (45:1-5)?
  
2. What nation did the Lord bring judgment against (46:1-12)?
  
3. Who did the Lord use to bring judgment on this nation (46:13-26)?
  
4. What is mentioned in Jeremiah 46:25 that was part of the cause for the Lord's judgment on Egypt?
  
5. What promise did the Lord give to his people in the midst of this coming judgment (46:27-28)?
  
6. What other nation did the Lord bring judgment against (47:1-7)?

**Digging Deeper**

1. When did the word of the Lord come to Baruch (45:1; see also 46:2)? Who was Baruch and where previously in Jeremiah did he write the Lord's words in a book (45:1)?
  
2. What did the Lord say in Jeremiah 45:4-5 that introduces the judgment section of Jeremiah 46-52?

3. Who was Pharaoh-necho king of Egypt (46:2) and what connection did he have with Josiah king of Judah (2 K. 23:29-35)?
  
4. Where was Carchemish located and when did Pharaoh-necho and Nebuchadnezzar battle there (46:2; see also 2 Chron. 35:20; Isa. 10:9)?
  
5. Where are the following places in Egypt located on a map: Euphrates (46:2, 6, 10), Cush, Put, and Ludim (46:9), Midgol, Memphis, and Tahpanhes (46:14, 19), and, Amon and No (46:25).
  
6. Who were the people “out of the north” that brought judgment upon Egypt and Philistia (46:2, 10, 13, 20, 24; 47:2)?
  
7. Where are the following places near Philistia located on a map: Gaza (47:1, 5), Tyre, Sidon, and the isle of Caphtor (47:4), and, Ashkelon (47:5, 7)

### **Applications for Today**

1. Do not seek great things (selfish ambition) for yourself (45:5; Mt. 20:20-28; Phil. 2:1-4).
2. The Lord judges all nations (46:1, 12, 28; Mt. 25:30).
3. The day of the Lord is a day of judgment (46:10; 2 Pet. 3:8-10).
4. The Lord is King (46:18; 1 Tim. 1:17).
5. Do not trust in false gods or man, but in the Lord (46:25; Psa. 40:4; 146:3; Jer. 17:7).
6. The Lord will judge his people, but he will not completely cast them off (46:27-28; Psa. 94:14; Rom. 11:1-2).
7. The day of the Lord is a day of destruction for the wicked (47:4; 2 Pet. 3:7).
