8. What desert tribe did the Lord judge in Jeremiah 49:28-33?

9. What nation did the Lord judge in Jeremiah 49:34-39?

Digging Deeper

1. Where are the following locations found on a map: Moab and its cities (48:1-47), Ammon and its cities (49:1-6), Edom and its cities (49:7-22), Damascus and its cities (49:23-27), Kedar and its tribes (49:28-33), and Elam (49:34-39)?
2. Who was Malcam or Milcom (49:1, 3)?
3. Who did the Lord use to bring judgment upon these nations (49:28, 30)?
4. When was the beginning of the reign of Zedekiah (49:34)?

Applications for Today

1. Do not trust in anyone or anything other than the Lord (48:7; 49:4; 2 Cor. 1:9).
2. We do not need to be negligent in doing the Lord's work (48:10; 1 Cor. 15:58).
3. We do not need to be settled and at ease in our service to the Lord (48:11; Rev. 3:16).
4. The Lord is King (48:15; 1 Tim. 1:17).
5. The Lord judges all idolatry and pride (48:7, 11, 13, 18, 26-30, 35; 49:1, 3-4, 16; 1 Cor. 10:14; Jas. 4:6; 1 Pet. 5:5; Rev. 21:8).
6. The Lord visits sinful people with judgment (48:44; Lk. 19:44).
7. We must follow the Lord's wisdom, not man's wisdom (49:7; 1 Cor. 3:18-23).
8. The Lord's anger is against all nations who sin against him (49:37; Rev. 14:10).
