3. What were the two witnesses told to do (11:3-4; see also 11:6-7, 10)?
4. What happened to those who tried to hurt the two witnesses (11:5)?
5. What power did the two witnesses have (11:6)?
6. Who killed the two witnesses (11:7)?
7. What happened to the dead bodies of the two witnesses (11:8-10)?
8. What happened to the dead bodies of the two witnesses after 3 ½ days (11:11-12)?
9. What happened in the great earthquake (11:13)?
10. What is past and what is coming in Revelation 11:14 (see 8:13; 9:12)?

11. What did the great voices in heaven say about God's kingdom when the seventh angel sounded his trumpet (11:15)?

12. What did the 24 elders say about God's power (11:16-17)?

13. What did John see in the temple of God in heaven (11:18)?

• **Digging Deeper**

1. Where is the "temple" located in the book of Revelation (11:1-2; see 3:12; 7:15; 11:19; 14:15-17; 15:5-8; 16:1, 17)?

2. How long is 42 months and 1260 days what do these period of times represent (11:2-3; see 12:6, 14; 13:5; Dan. 7:25; 12:7)?

3. What significance do witnesses, olive trees (oil), and candlesticks have in the Bible (11:3-4)?

4. Who in the OT had the power to keep the heaven from raining (11:6)?

5. Where previous in Revelation is the "abyss" mentioned (11:7)?

6. What city is the "great city" (11:8; see 16:19; 17:18; 18:10, 16, 18, 19, 21)?

7. What is written in Daniel 7 that speaks of the Roman Empire and its destruction, the persecution of Christians, and the establishment of God's everlasting kingdom (11:7, 15-18)

8. Who communed with Israel above the Ark of the Covenant and what was placed inside the ark (11:19)?

• **Applications for Today**

1. Faithful members of the Lord's church will faithfully proclaim God's message to the world (11:3-6). But, ungodly men will show disdain for message of these faithful members (11:7-10). What should faithful Christians do concerning God's message (Acts 8:4; Eph. 6:10; Col. 4:3; 2 Tim. 2:2)? Why do some people not want God's message (Acts 5:33; 7:54; 13:45; 17:5, 32; 19:9; 24:25; 2 Thess. 2:10-12; 2 Tim. 4:2-4)?

2. God's great kingdom and powerful reign are over all mankind and forever (11:15-18). How did the angel describe Jesus' kingdom to Mary (Lk. 1:31-33)? What will happen to all who will not let Jesus reign over them (Lk. 19:14, 27)? What must Christians do in order to reign with Jesus (2 Tim. 2:12)?
