• Applications for Today

1. The 144,000 are saints who are identified with God's name, are purchased, are pure, and are obedient (14:1-5). How are Christians purchased (Acts 20:28; Rev. 5:9) and how are Christians to act who are purchased (1 Cor. 6:19; 7:23)?
2. The eternal gospel (good tidings) needs to be proclaimed to every person (14:6-7). What do people fail to do with the good tidings they hear (Heb. 4:2, 4)?
3. The kingdoms of men will fall, but the kingdom of God will stand (14:8). What kind o kingdom are Christians a part of (Heb. 12:28)?
4. Those who worship anyone or anything other than the one, true God will suffer eternal torment (14:9-11). What kind of worship is a lie (Rom. 1:25)?
5. It is important for Christians to be patient (steadfast) in their obedience to God's commands and the faith of Jesus (14:12). What does patience (steadfastness) produce (Rom. 5:4; Jas. 1:2-4)?
