6. What did Babylon say about herself and what did the Lord God do to her (18:7-8)?

7. How did the kings, merchants, and sailors react to the fall of Babylon (18:9-19)?

8. Why were the saints told to rejoice over Babylon's fall (18:20)?

9. What did a strong angel do that symbolized the fall of Babylon (18:21)?

10. What was not found any longer in Babylon after her fall (18:22-23)?

11. What was found in Babylon that caused her to be judged by God (18:24)?

## • Digging Deeper

- 1. Where previous in the book of Revelation were we introduced to the fall of Babylon (18:2)?
- 2. Where previous in the book of Revelation do we read of Rome's immoral character (18:2-3)?
- 3. Where previous in the book of Revelation do we read of saints being killed by Rome (18:24)?
