1. What did John hear from a great multitude in heaven concerning God (19:1-3)?
2. What did John hear from the four living creatures concerning God (19:4-5)?
3. What else did John hear concerning God (19:6)?
4. What was the occasion for rejoicing and what was the wife of the Lamb wearing (19:7-8)?
5. What was John told to write and why was he rebuked (19:9-10)?
6. How did John describe the one (Jesus) who rode on a white horse with respect to the following (19:11-16)?
 - His name –
 - His appearance –
 - His armies –
 - His work –
7. What did an angel invite the birds to do (19:17-18, 21)?
8. Who warred against the one (Jesus) who sat on the white horse (19:19)?

9. What happened to the beast and the false prophet when the war was over (19:20) and what happened to the rest (19:21)?

• Digging Deeper

1. Where in the NT is the relationship between Christ and Christians compared to a marriage (19:6-9)?
2. Where previous in the book of Revelation are we told about kings being called to gather for “war” against God (19:17-21)? What kind of “war” is it, who were the combatants, when and where did it take place (Rev. 11:7; 12:7, 17; 13:4, 7; 16:14; 17:12-14; 19:11, 19)?

• Applications for Today

1. It is good to praise God: “Hallelujah” (19:1-6). What reason do Christians have to praise God (Rom. 15:9; Eph. 1:14; Phil. 1:11)?
2. Blessed are those who are joined to Christ in marriage (19:7-9). What is Jesus called in the gospels (Jn. 3:29)? Who will be with Jesus at the “marriage feast” when he comes and who will not be with him (Mt. 25:10-13)? How did Paul describe the relationship between Christ and Christians (2 Cor. 11:2; Eph. 5:30, 32)? How do Christians, the bride, engage in “righteous acts” (see Cain in Heb. 11:4; 1 Jn. 3:12)?
3. Let us always remember to worship God and none other (19:10). What kinds of things do some people worship (Ezek. 14:3-7; Mt. 4:9; Rom. 1:25; Acts 10:25-26; Col. 2:18)?
4. Jesus is the Faithful and True, the Word of God, and the King of Kings (19:11-16). What, in addition to Jesus, are “faithful and true” in this book (Rev. 21:5; 22:6)? What is Jesus called in John 1:1? Who overcomes with the King of Kings and Lord of Lords (Rev. 17:14)?
