3. What did the red horse rider come forth to do (6:3-4)?
4. What did the black horse rider have in his hand (6:5-6)?
5. What was the name of the pale horse rider (6:7-8)?
6. What did John see when the fifth seal was opened (6:9)?
7. What question was cried out by those who had been slain for the word of God (6:10)?
8. What answer was given to those who had been slain (6:11)?
9. What did John see when the sixth seal was opened (6:12-14)?
10. Who tried to hide themselves (6:15)?

11. What were these people trying to hide from (6:16-17)?

12. What question did John ask at the end of chapter 6 (6:17)?

• Digging Deeper

1. What are the “seven seals” used for that are mentioned in this chapter (6:1) and how is chapter 6 connected with chapter 5?

2. Who in the OT saw visions which included colored horses – white, red, black, and pale (6:2, 4, 5, 8), and what do these colors represent?

3. How much was a denarius in NT times (6:6)?

4. What is the significance of being “underneath the altar” (6:9; see Lev. 4:7) and where is the altar located (see 9:13)?

5. Where else in the Bible are changes in the earth, sun, moon, and stars associated with God’s judgment against a nation (6:12-13)?

• Applications for Today

1. Jesus, the Lamb, is in control of Rome and all other nations (6:1). What prophecy of Jesus and the nations is contained in Psalm 2:9?

2. Souls who are persecuted for the word of God will be rewarded in heaven one day (6:9). What do these faithful souls not do (Rev. 20:4)?

3. God will right (avenge) all wrongs (6:10). What will God do for his elect and why (Lk. 18:7-8)? What must Christians not do regarding avenging (Rom. 12:19)?

4. We do not want to face the wrath of the Lamb in judgment (6:16-17). What do people get who do not obey God (Jn. 3:36; Rom. 1:18; 2:5,8; Eph. 5:6)?
